






His reductive technique and meditative approach challenge the physical and poetic boundaries of his materials, canceling the idea of restrictions within his work allows him to analyze it with no limitations and using printed matter as a physical way of expression. Much of Hassan's success is attributed to his unique ability to express dramatic and emotional content through publications and printmaking.
